These 11 one-bedroom apartments are the first public phase of the Coleman Foundation's Touching Lives, Changing Destinies capital endowment campaign. The total cost of \$900,000. A matching grant from the ODMH provided \$437,000. A generous trust distribution from Walter Capling's family of \$166,500 got the ball rolling. Since then the Foundation has been working to raise the balance. Currently, \$107,000 still needs to be raised.
